



Golf Cart & Side by Side Vehicle Operating Policies and Rules

Golf Carts and Side by Side vehicles (collectively referred to herein as Carts) are a huge part of the culture at Salmon Lake Park + Resort (Park). We want everyone to enjoy their time and experience at the Park, therefore the following policies and rules are in place to help promote the safety of our guests and our teammates.

- ✓ ONLY Golf Cart and Side by Side Vehicles are permitted; no ATV's, unregistered motorcycles, or any other motorized recreational vehicle is approved for use in the Park.
- ✓ All cart operators are responsible for their guests and must make sure that the guests know and follow these rules.
- ✓ Carts are to only be operated on park roads and must not exceed 10 MPH.
- ✓ Carts are NOT to be operated in such a manner, or in such locations, as to damage or disturb soil, grass, or other natural resources of the property.
DO NOT OPERATE OR PARK ANY CART ON OR AROUND THE LAKE'S DAM OR NEAR THE WATER.
- ✓ Golf Car & UTV Usage Hours:
 - o 9 AM to 10 PM

Please note: We are not out to harass guests utilizing necessary facilities, such as the bathhouses, Store, etc. We are targeting guests "cruising" around the campground, generally making noise or infringing on other guest's desire to peacefully enjoy the park.
- ✓ All carts brought in by a guest must have liability insurance. Proof of insurance must be provided upon request.
- ✓ **Carts may only be operated by a licensed driver** in possession of a valid driver's license or be accompanied by a **licensed parent, guardian, or other adult family member who is legally able to bear financial responsibility for the actions or failures of the unlicensed driver, who is seated in the front passenger's seat with full access to all of the vehicle's controls at all times, and who is not in any way impaired or unstable to maintain control of the vehicle and its operation at all times. Minimum age for non-licensed driver is 15 years old.**
- ✓ Carts must NOT be operated between sunset and sunrise without showing at least one (1) white head lamp and one red tail lamp at all times.
- ✓ Cart must be maintained to prevent unnecessary noise, smoke, or other common nuisances.
- ✓ Cart may NOT be operated recklessly, or with disregard for the safety of passengers or other park guests.
- ✓ Carts may not be operated by any intoxicated or otherwise impaired person.

Release & Hold Harmless Agreement

I _____, the undersigned party understands that all golf cart and UTV activities are dangerous. There are known and unknown risks which can cause injury or even death. I agree that Salmon Lake Enterprises, LP dba Salmon Lake Park + Resort, its owners, partners, employees, agents or assigns, volunteers, or vendors (collectively referred to as the Park) shall not be held responsible or liable for any loss, property damage, bodily injury, accident or loss of life occurring while the Cart is in my or my guest's possession or control. I further assume full and complete responsibility for any injury to myself and/or other persons, or for any damage to property resulting from and arising out of my use, operation, storage or transportation of carts, whether leased or personally owned, in possession or control of me or my guests. I hereby release and discharge and agree to hold harmless the Park from and claims and demands whatsoever in law or in equity that may in any circumstance result from or in any way be connected with my or my guest's use of a golf cart or UTV in the Park.
